漢方薬が奏効した陰部痛2症例

要旨: 漢方薬が奏効した陰部痛2症例を経験したので報告する.

症例1:50歳代 男性. 主訴:下腹部から陰部に電気が走るような痛みと右手のこわばり. X年4月中旬腰痛後,下腹部から陰部に発作的なびりびりした痛みがでるため5月下旬当科受診された. 抑肝散加陳皮半夏, 疎経活血湯を処方し,1週間後痛みが完全に消失し,右手のこわばりも改善したため,同処方を2週間処方し終診とした. 症例2:70歳代 男性. 主訴:陰部痛. 座位や歩行で痛みが増強(NRS6~7). X-3年12月睾丸と肛門の間に痛みが出現した. CT検査で異常なく,原因不明で症状も改善しないため,X年7月下旬受診となる. 牛車腎気丸,治打僕一方を処方し,1週間後少し痛みが楽になり,継続処方とした.1ヵ月後,歩行時痛が軽減し,運動が可能となった.6ヵ月後ほぼ痛みなくなるまで改善した. 結語:駆瘀血剤を主体とし,証に合わせた漢方療法で有効な結果が得られた.

Two Cases of Vulvodynia in which Kampo Medicine Responded Masanori OGATA*1, Tetsuya HAYASHI*2 and Takashi KAWASAKI*2

Abstract: We report two cases of vulvodynia which were treated successfully by Kampo medicine. Case 1: The patient is a male in his 50s. One month after suffering from lumbago, he experienced pain that electricity ran from the belly to the pudenda, and he visited our hospital. He complained that there was also stiffness on his right hand. After medicine examination of Kampo medicine, he was prescribed both of sokeikakketsuto and yokukansankachimpihange. One week after taking these Kampo medicine, his pain completely disappeared and stiffness of the right hand improved. Case 2: The patient is a male in his 70s. He was suffering from sharp pain between testicle and an anus for 3 years. The pain was reinforced by walking and sitting position. After detailed examination including CT, the cause of pain was unknown at several hospitals. He visited our hospital because of walk disturbance due to vulvodynia. After medicine examination of Kampo medicine, he was prescribed both of jidabokuippo and goshajinkigan. One week after taking these Kampo medicine, he felt less pain. After one month, he could walk without severe pain. After six months, his pain was diminished almost completely. Sokeikakketsuto and jidabokuippo are said to improve blood stagnation. Effective results for vulvodynia were obtained when these medicines were prescribed by Kampo medicine method.
