身体症状症と診断され、精神疾患・心理社会的要因が原因と考えられる非菌原性歯痛に対し漢方薬が奏功した症例

要旨：精神疾患・心理社会的要因が原因と考えられる非菌原性歯痛に対して、抑肝散が奏功した症例を経験した。症例は33歳の男性、主訴に見合う器質的疾患を口腔内に認めず、精神科医との連携によって、精神疾患・心理社会的要因が原因と考えられる非菌原性歯痛/身体症状症と診断するに至った。我々の経験から、神経症傾向を有し、身体症状症と診断された非菌原性歯痛に対して抑肝散は一定の効果を示すことが示唆された。

Abstract: We experienced a case that yokukansan (Yi-Gan San) successfully treated non-odontogenic toothache that was thought to be caused by psychiatric disorders and psychosocial factors. The patient is a 33-year-old man, presented no organic disease which consisted of the chief complaint in his oral cavity. In collaboration with psychiatrists, we came to the diagnosis of non-odontogenic toothache/somatic symptom, which was thought to be caused by psychiatric disorders and psychosocial factors.

Our experience suggests that yokukansan has a certain effect on non-odontogenic toothache that has neurotic tendencies and is considered to be somatosympomatic.
